**Limited Product Warranty Policy**

**WARRANTY DEFINITION and COVERAGE**

The S-TEC Corporation Limited Product Warranty Policy is applicable to specific products as outlined below for the product owner, and is transferable.

S-TEC Corporation agrees to repair or replace at S-TEC's option, and without charge, any unit, part, or accessory which has been operated under normal conditions for which the unit was intended and is found to be defective in material, design, or workmanship, for the following periods:

	Aftermarket Installations	24 months	From the date of S-TEC product installation approval. Warranty period shall not exceed 27 months from the date the system is shipped from the S-TEC factory.
	S-TEC Factory Installations	30 months	From the date of S-TEC product installation approval.
S-TEC Autopilot Systems	Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM)	24 months	From the delivery date of the aircraft to the retail customer. Warranty period shall not exceed 30 months from the issuance date of the original aircraft airworthiness certificate.
	Aftermarket Installations	12 months	From the date of S-TEC product installation approval. Warranty period shall not exceed 14 months from the date the system is shipped from the S-TEC factory.
	S-TEC Factory Installations	18 months	From the date of S-TEC product installation approval.
	Experimental Aircraft Installations	18 months	From the date the product is shipped from the S-TEC factory.
	New Unit Purchase	12 months	From the date the product is shipped from the S-TEC factory.

System	Installation Type	Warranty Period	Warranty Period Description
Repair Station and Aircraft "Fly-In" Repairs	Repair Station Unit Repairs	90 days	From the date the repaired unit is shipped from the S-TEC factory. Warranty coverage is limited to the repairs accomplished only.
	Aircraft "Fly-In" System Repairs	120 days	From the date the customer picks-up the aircraft.
	Serviceable Unit Purchase or Non-Warranty Exchange	180 days	From the date the product is shipped from the S-TEC factory.

Within the warranty coverage period, any new S-TEC system unit with less than ninety (90) days time in service will be repaired or replaced with a new unit at no charge. After ninety (90) days time in service while still within the warranty coverage period, a unit will be repaired or replaced with a serviceable unit at no charge. Any replacement unit will retain warranty status of original unit.

**Note: Repair/Replace decisions are at the sole discretion of S-TEC Corporation.**

## WARRANTY REQUIREMENTS

Warranty repairs/exchanges shall be accomplished only through an authorized S-TEC dealer. A list of authorized dealers can be found on our website: [www.s-tec.com](http://www.s-tec.com)

The following conditions apply before warranty will be allowed on S-TEC products:

1. Warranty registration is the responsibility of the equipment owner and shall be submitted to S-TEC within 30 days of new aircraft purchase or S-TEC product installation approval. Additional warranty registration forms or online registration may be found on our website: [www.s-tec.com](http://www.s-tec.com)
2. Warranty registration is required for system and/or unit purchases.
3. Without verifiable warranty registration, proof of acceptable warranty status is the responsibility of the owner and shall be demonstrated by one of the following methods:
  - a. *Aftermarket* - Copy of aircraft maintenance logbook entry identifying S-TEC system installation approval by an authorized S-TEC dealer **OR** Copy of FAA Form 337 identifying S-TEC system installation approval by an authorized S-TEC dealer

- b. *OEM* - Copy of aircraft sales invoice and original aircraft airworthiness certificate
  - c. *Experimental Aircraft* - Copy of S-TEC shipping document or packing list
4. Notice of an S-TEC unit/system failure or malfunction must be provided to S-TEC Corporation or an authorized dealer within the specified warranty period.
  5. S-TEC components must have been installed in accordance with FAA approved data in type certified aircraft with S-TEC published instructions by an authorized S-TEC dealer or authorized OEM.

**Note: S-TEC products installed in type certified aircraft by other than S-TEC or authorized S-TEC Dealers/OEMs shall void all warranty.**

6. S-TEC components altered, modified, or repaired by other than an authorized S-TEC dealer, authorized OEM, or S-TEC Corporation shall void all warranty.

## WARRANTY LIMITATIONS

The installation of an autopilot requires that the aircraft and systems to which the autopilot interfaces be in sound mechanical condition and that the aircraft is rigged per the manufacturer's maintenance documentation. In addition, installation of the autopilot per the approved data is necessary for the autopilot system to operate as designed and approved. S-TEC Corporation has made every effort to provide an autopilot system that will provide reliable and consistent service for your aircraft. Accordingly, the following categories are not covered under the S-TEC warranty:

1. Adjustments for interface with other avionics systems
2. Bridle cable adjustments
3. Roll centering adjustments
4. Audio volume adjustments
5. Loss of use of the aircraft
6. Pilot services
7. Fuel / oil / general maintenance
8. Travel expenses
9. Unit repairs due to improper installation, misuse, abuse, accident, or acts of God

**Warranty claims are subject to review by S-TEC Corporation, and all decisions are final.**

*Installation of S-TEC Corporation products is the responsibility of the installer. S-TEC Corporation liability under this warranty is limited to hardware products supplied by S-TEC to the installer. S-TEC Corporation shall, in no event, be liable for incidental or consequential damages resulting from product use or installation.*
